

Sublette County Historical Society, the parent organization for the Museum of the Mountain Man, is Wyoming's first historical society. From humble beginnings in 1936, the Sublette County Historical Society has gained a national reputation as an organization dedicated to preserving the history and culture of the nineteenth century American Mountain Man and the era of the Rocky Mountain Fur Trade.

Only sixteen Rendezvous were held during the height of the Rocky Mountain Fur Trade. Of those, six were located in the Green River Valley, eight miles west of Pinedale, Wy. Today, the heritage of the mountain man still lies close to the surface in the "Upper Green" as the residents of the county rekindle the flame of Rendezvous past in the annual Green River Rendezvous Pageant. The pageant was True West Magazines, "Best Mounted Re-enactment" of 2025.

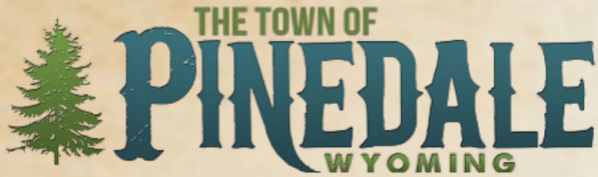

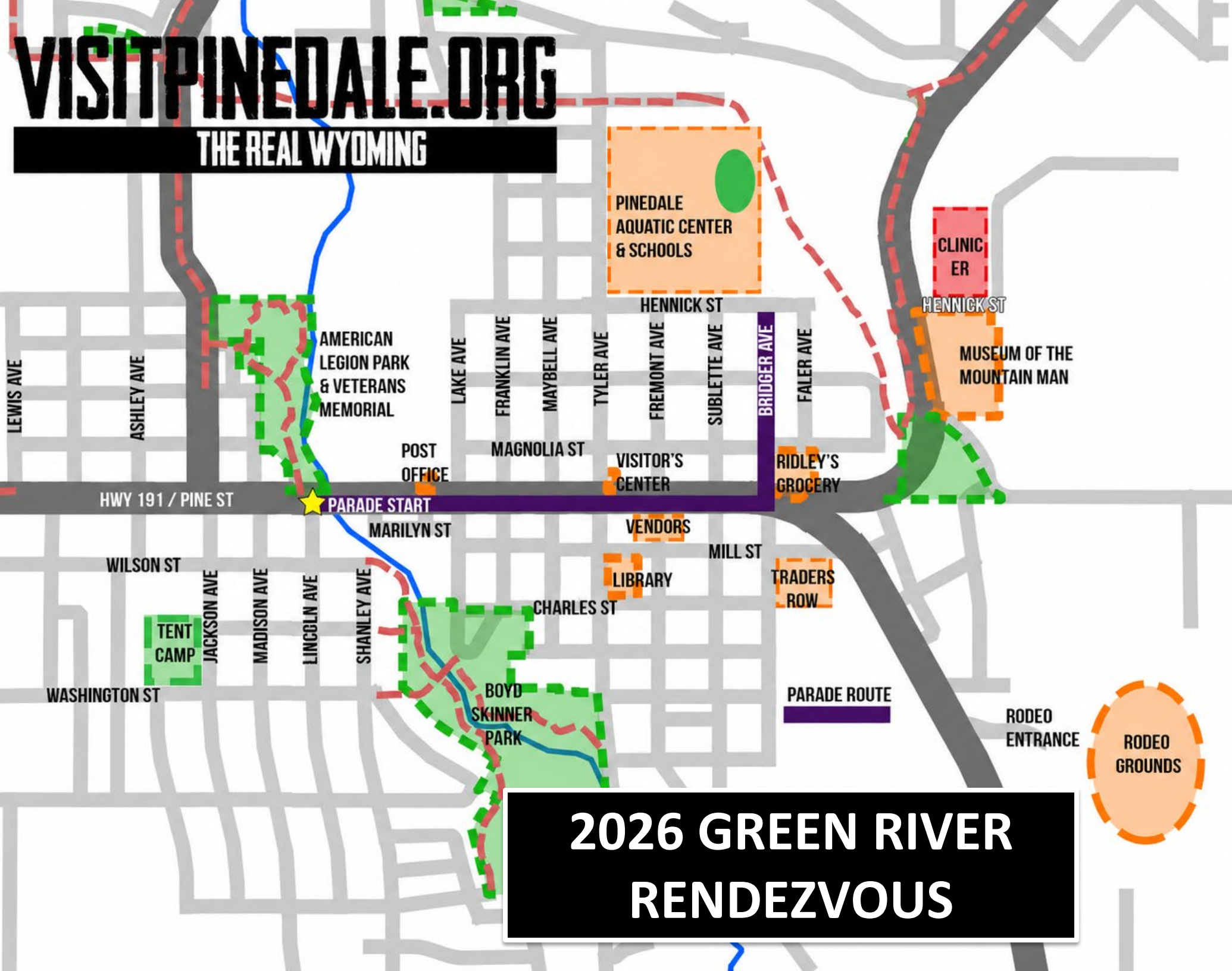
